Kempley Climate Conversations Sharing the Benefits

Kempley Parish Council declared a climate emergency in 2020 and are committed to helping our community address some of the issues around climate change. The Parish Council has asked Bob Earll and Mark Worrilow to develop an initiative with Kempley residents.

Conversations To get the ball rolling, Mark and I would like to have some conversations with Kempley residents to explore their views about the climate crisis. These conversations will be confidential and the information from them will help shape the way forward that best fits our community. This will last about an hour and a half and be based around four main questions, and a conversation following this concerning your personal views. If at some stage we use the information that you provide this will *not* be attributed to you.

The **Sharing the Benefits** initiative will explore resident's response to the climate change, over-consumption and nature emergencies. There are many benefits that result from taking personal action and we feel that sharing these is a positive and constructive way to respond. Starting in May 2021 and continuing until the autumn we will have conversations with residents about their views. We are not proposing any projects at present; this may emerge from the conversations once we find how best we might help. We will seek your views on how we proceed.
