
Highways Report - Signage

Highway Discussion on Signage

A key component of the Kempley Daffodil Weekend Grant from the County Council was the purchase and installation of new village signs designed with the new visual image now being adopted for most of the major organisations in our community.

The County Highways Department have now agreed a new design that allows the use of the new colour scheme . A copy of the design is shown below:



The new sign does not include a Daffodil and this has been raised with the Highways Department as a minor modification.

The design has been presented to the Chair of the Kempley Daffodil weekend who has consented to the new signs. The signage will enhance the image of the village and support the annual Daffodil Weekend .

The budget in the **Build Back Better Grant** of £4,000 will fund the purchase of the 7 signs (circa £120 per sign) required for all highway entry points to the Parish. It is recommended that approval be given to the Parish Clerk to arrange the final details with the County Highways Department. This will include instruction to Morelock signs on the final colour specification, and font size, as well as agreement with County Highways on final locations, and installation costs.

Recommendation – Approval to proceed be authorised based on the above design and subject to funds remaining within budget.
