- Working with the Daffodil Committee to support the 2022 Daffodil Weekend
- ✤ A successful bid to Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) for grant funding to help reestablish this event after the Covid Pandemic
- Support to farmers and walkers, agreeing and installing new kissing gates on public rights of way
- Gaining financial support for these from Gill Mosely, our County Councillor, which along with the grant for the Daffodil Weekend more than doubled the precept (budget) for the year
- ✤ A Christmas tree and lights on the Village Green
- Working with the Village Hall Committee to support Platinum Jubilee celebrations
- Progress on the Kempley Community Broadband Scheme
