## Re: M50 westbound junction 1 to junction 2 resurfacing

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming essential resurfacing on the M50 westbound between junction 1 and junction 2. As part of the resurfacing work, we'll also be renewing the road markings and studs to provide a smoother, safer carriageway for road users.

### When will this work take place?

We'll be carrying out work overnight, between **9pm and 6am**, from **Monday 20 March 2023 to Friday 24 March 2023**.

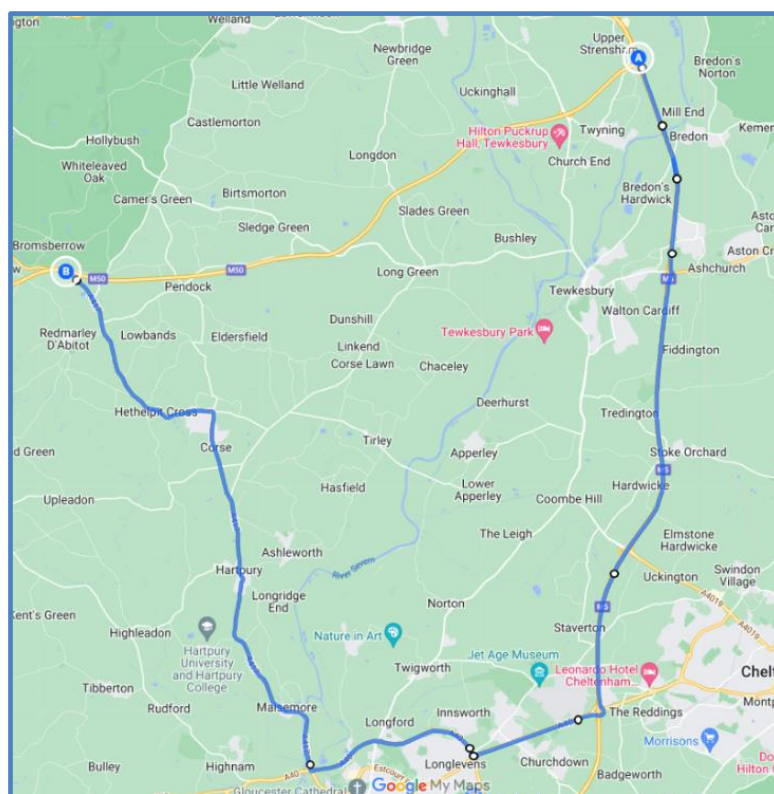
In order to carry out this work safely, the M50 westbound will be closed from junction 1 to junction 2. Daytime lane closures will also be in place including hard shoulder with a speed restriction of 50mph.

### What does this mean for you?

During the closures, a fully signed diversion will be in place, please see below. Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained throughout.

We'll make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to a minimum. We always aim to work to the programme, however unforeseen circumstances or adverse weather conditions may mean changes.
